As a member of the UKQAA we make it easy for you to be informed of the latest legislation affecting our industry and how this could affect you.

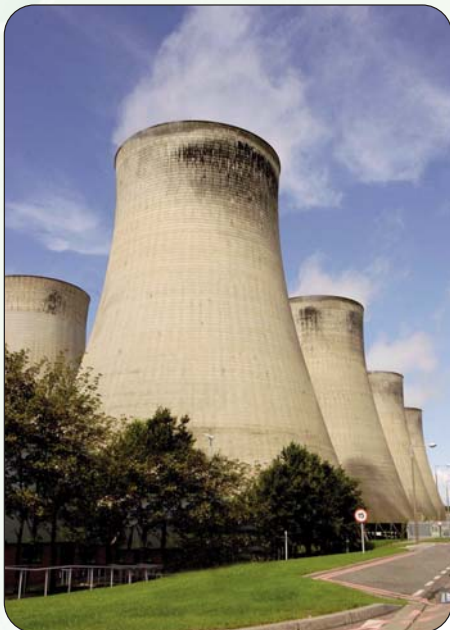
The UK Quality Ash Association is a trade association which was formed in 1997 representing the producers and users of UK coal fired power station ash products such as pulverised fuel ash (PFA - also known as fly ash in some applications), furnace bottom ash (FBA) and cenospheres. We promote members interests of a scientific, technical, environmental, educational and legal nature associated with all applications. We sponsor research and promote the range of applications for ash products through printed and electronic media, representation on European and UK standardisation committees, exhibitions, lectures, etc.

Until relatively recently there have only been two categories of membership available - Full and Associate. Full Members, being the major contributors to the association, have ultimate responsibility for its operation. Associate Members are users of PFA and FBA who receive most of the benefits of Full membership but without voting rights.

A third category of membership is now available called Affiliate membership for smaller companies or companies with a limited interest in ash but with some form of connection to the ash industry e.g. grouting and civil engineering contractors, material processors, hauliers, etc.

As an Affiliate Member you will receive a quarterly newsletter updating you on issues within and affecting the ash industry. The newsletter contains information on both National and European standardisation issues, environmental aspects, EU directives and laws affecting the industry, presentations, conferences, seminars etc that the UKQAA are involved with. Your primary company name, address and a web site link are placed on the UKQAA web site. Plus information of interest will be regularly emailed to a nominated representative as and when appropriate. Your views will also be sort on issues that may affect you.

You can use the UKQAA Affiliate membership logo (as shown above) on your web site and publications for as long as you are a member. This logo is dated and applies from 1 July to 30 June of the following year (the UKQAA financial year).



Have the knowledge and expertise of the UKQAA behind you for little outlay with Affiliate membership fees being £500+VAT per annum (fees are reduced pro-rata on a quarterly basis for companies joining at times other than July). Your membership gives a single named representative the right to attend our AGM in a non-voting capacity.

Ash may not be your prime industry activity so Affiliate membership of the UK Quality Ash Association could be for you helping you keep your finger on the pulse with minimum effort.
